

## Homework Policy

1. Write down your homework in your agenda book on Monday. Most of the time homework will also be on the blog as a backup however you are expected to already have it in your agenda as well. Late homework will not be allowed because you did not write it down into your agenda.
2. All homework must be completed on time.
  - a. Exceptions will be made for absences. If absent, you will have only one day to complete homework assigned on the days you were absent.

For example: if you are absent Tuesday you are expected to have Monday night's homework done when you come in Thursday. You will be allowed however to turn in Tuesday night's homework on Friday (one day later only). It is your responsibility to meet with Ms. Manning or Mr. Mateas to catch up on material you missed.

3. Use pencil.
4. All homework must have:
  - Your name
  - The date
  - The page number
  - The problem number
5. Write neatly and show all your work clearly.
6. Make sure to clearly circle your final answer.
7. Homework will now be collected and graded based on two qualities: effort and correctness.

5 points will be awarded for overall effort on the assignment (no missing problems, all your work is shown, SEQ for problems you do not know how to solve)

5 points will be awarded for 1-2 questions that are graded for correctness.
